



Graham Calls for Release of 28-Pages and Full Investigation of Saudi Role in 9/11

Following the December 15th article which appeared in the [New York Post](#) [1] on the Saudi 9/11 connection, the [Huffington Post interviewed former U.S. Senator Bob Graham](#) [2], who was co-chair of the Congressional Joint Inquiry into 9/11. Graham emphasized that there are real consequences to the coverup of the Saudi role in 9/11. The families of the victims have been blocked by two administrations from obtaining justice. There is also the question of our foreign policy. Specifically, Graham said, based on our knowledge of Saudi involvement in 9/11, we have to ask, do we want such a perfidious ally?

Graham was asked what is the interest in protecting Saudi Arabia? He detailed the personal relationship between the Bush family and the Saudis, particularly Prince Bandar, and pointed out that as a result of Bandar's relationship with Bush, 140 Saudis were allowed to leave the U.S. by plane after 9/11 even though all other planes were grounded. There is also a national relationship which has existed since the end of World War II when we gave Saudi Arabia a defense capability in exchange for a secure supply of oil.

However, Graham emphasized, this special relationship is not good. There is a dark side to it. We have to ask, what are the Saudi long-term motivations? Thus far we have only scratched the surface. Graham said he hopes the coverage in the *New York Post* will lead to the release of the 28 pages, but also that it will result in reopening the case as a whole, including an investigation of Sarasota, Florida, Falls Church, Virginia, and Paterson, New Jersey. The result will be justice, but it will also provide clarity about the relationship with the Saudis.

Graham pointed out that the challenge has been that we must fight every step of the way against our own government and powerful agencies. Because of the suppression of the truth, the impression has been given that Saudi Arabia is a good ally. But there is a much darker side to Saudi Arabia. This includes its funding of madrassas (religious schools), the brainwashing of young Muslims and its financial support to Al Qaeda.

When that is known it will cause a sea change in the relationship.

When asked about the report in the [New York Times](#) [4] of a speech given by Prince

Turki denouncing the U.S., Graham said nobody would take that if they knew the truth.

In response to the question, whether he would call it a coverup? Graham said, "absolutely." Not only have the 28 pages been blacked out, but every element of the investigation has been obstructed. We know what happened in San Diego and Sarasota. There has been a pervasive and very successful coverup of the most significant event in modern U.S. history. When the truth is revealed it will change the entire narrative both pre and post 9/11.

When pressed on the effect on our relationship with Saudi Arabia if the truth were revealed, Graham asked, "are we such a servile nation that we have to capitulate to a country which may have been involved in the murder of 3,000 of our citizens because of the adverse reaction of the Kingdom if it is called to account?"
