Economic Forum. A sinister German accent reinforces his villain image. But [as I explain elsewhere](#), Schwab is more P.T. Barnum than Blofeld.

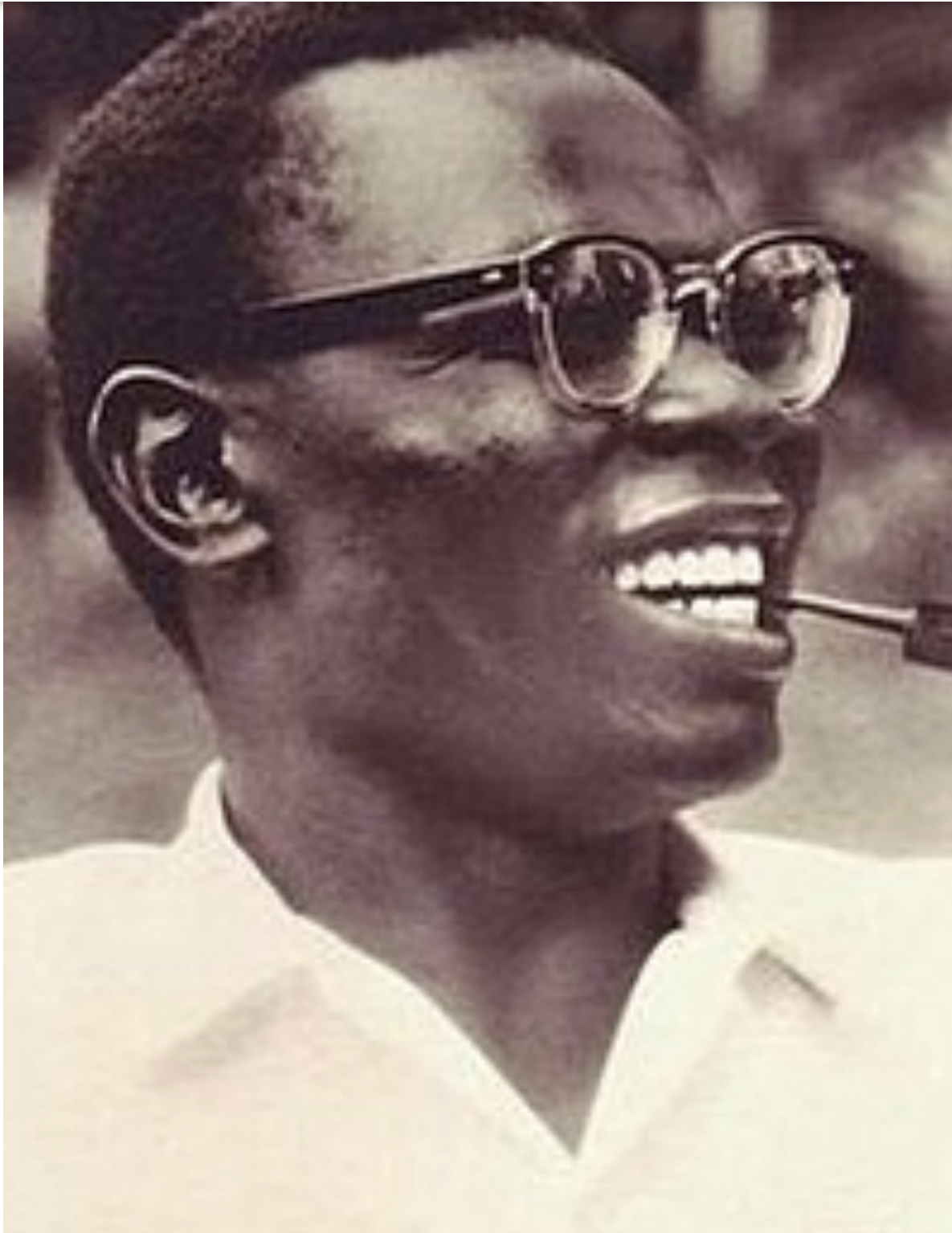

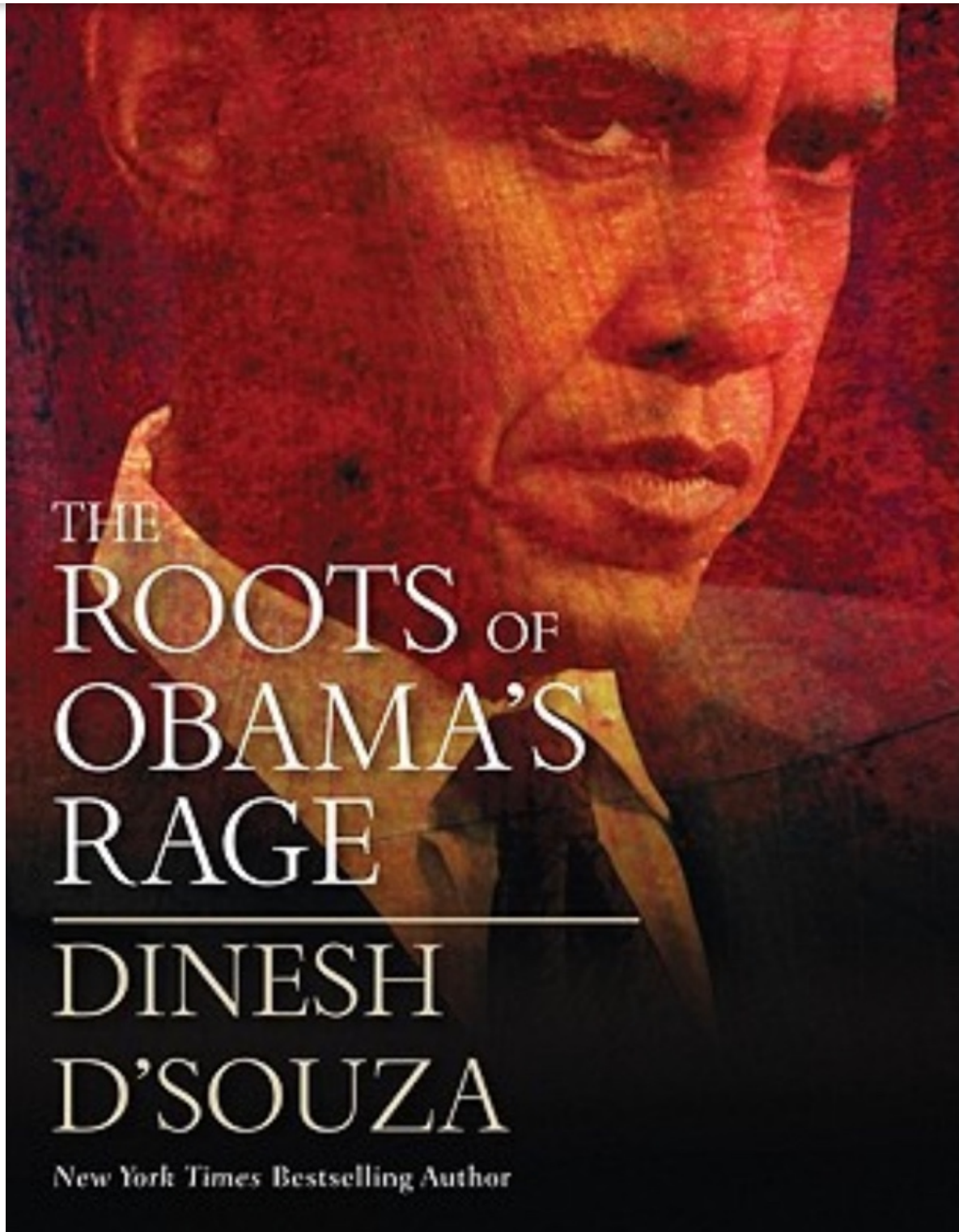


Dinesh answered the question: "He removed the bust of Winston Churchill from the Oval Office. This was a sign everyone missed of who Obama really is."

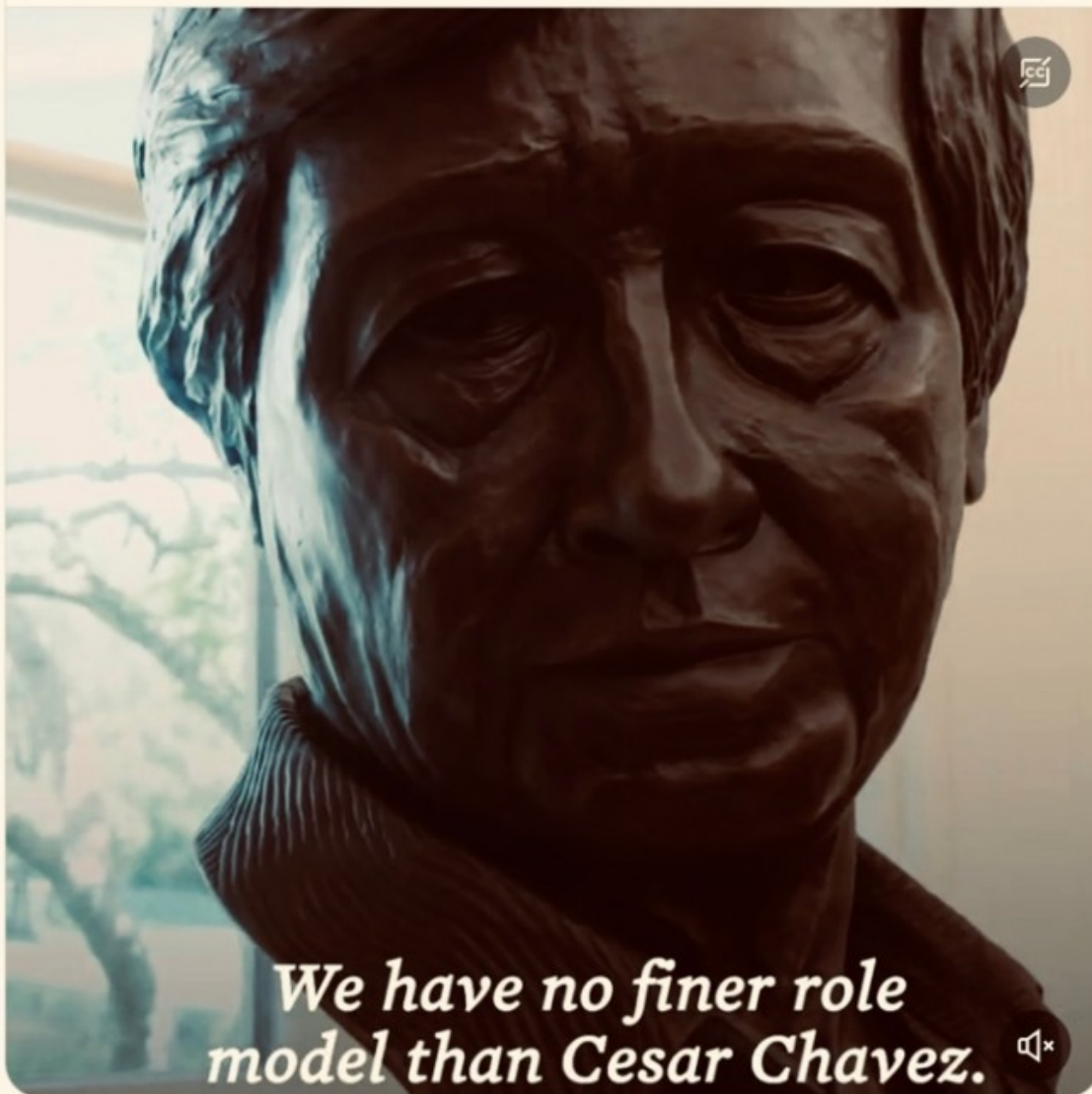

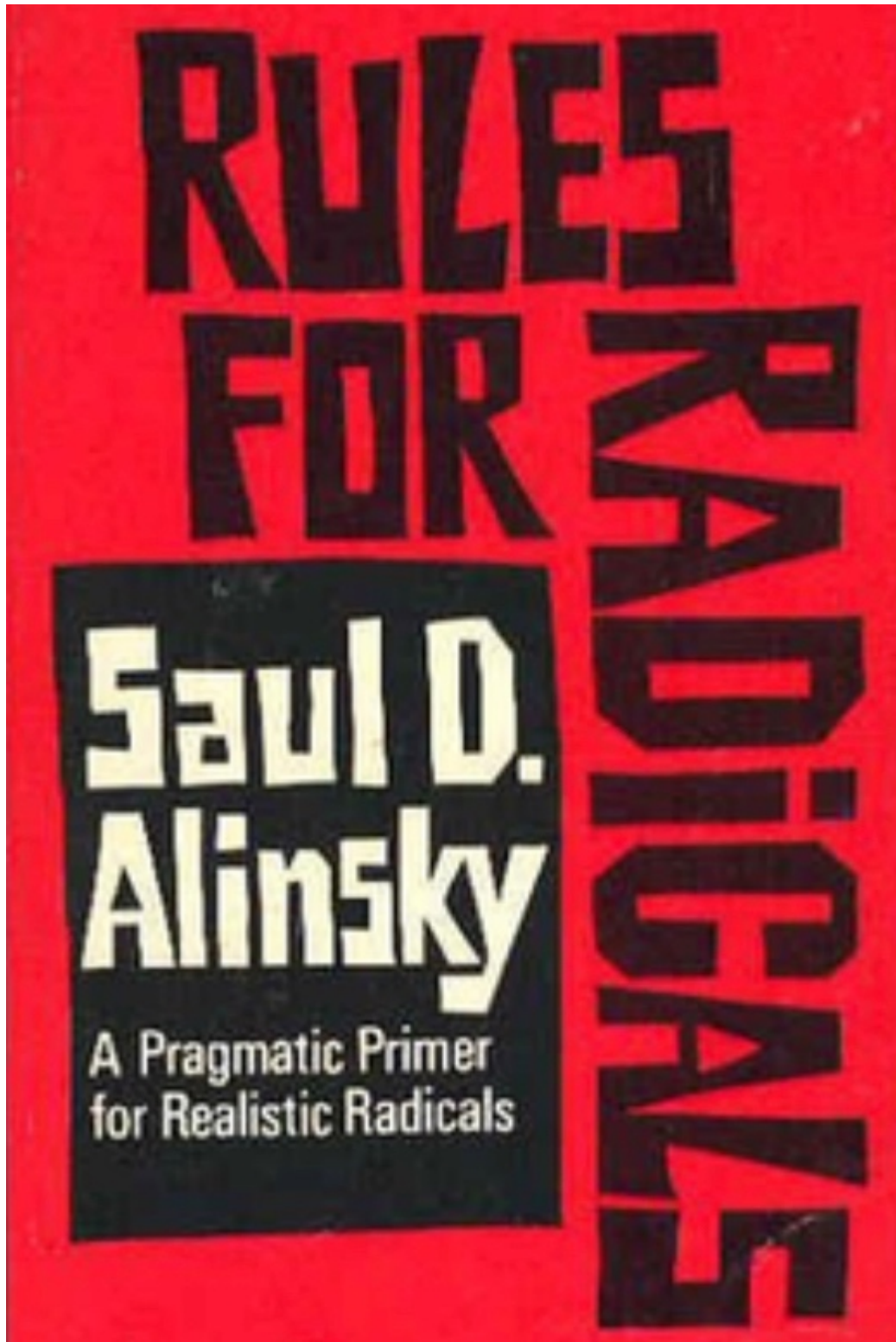

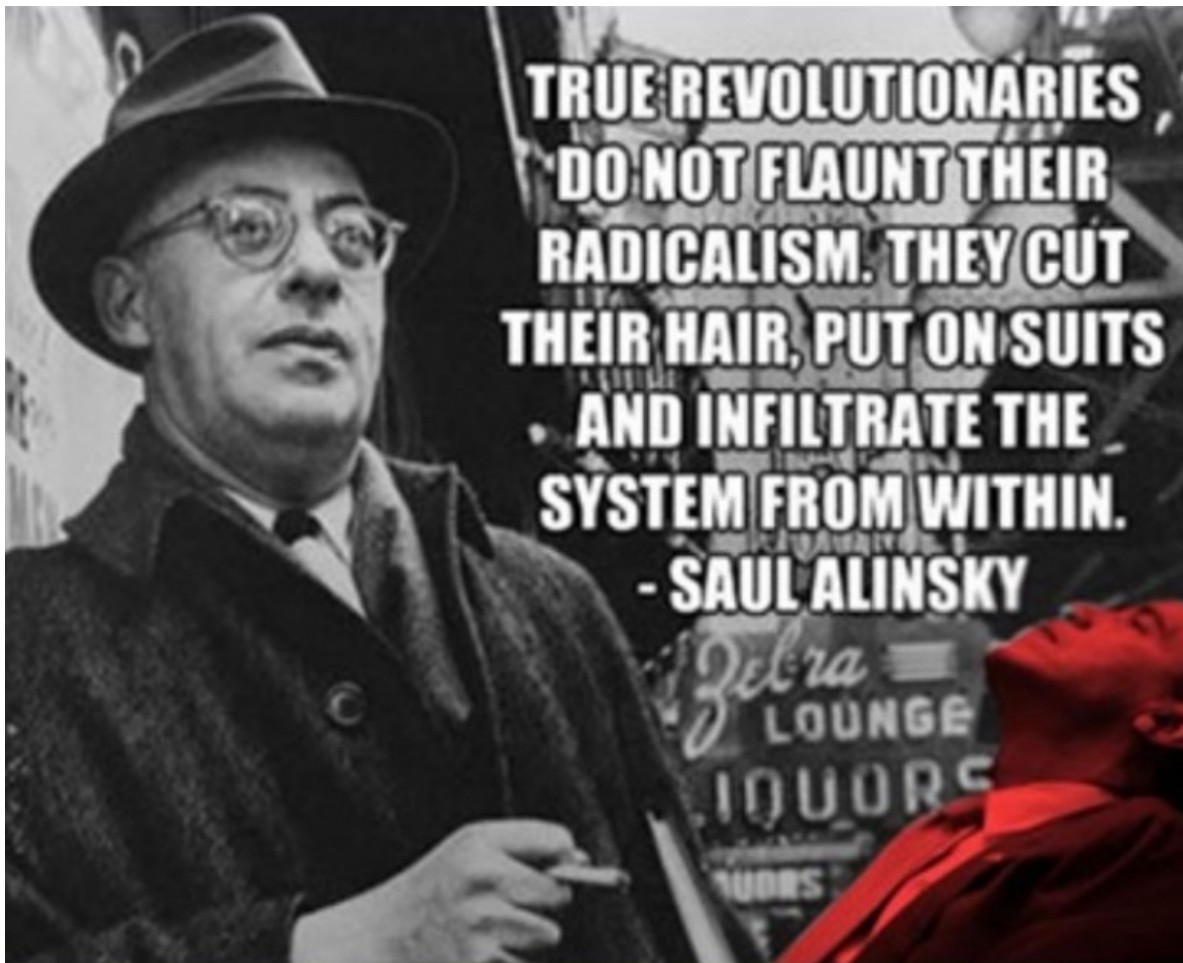


Boy, did President Joe Biden look sad Tuesday, wandering around a White House event unable to get attention from a roomful of Democrats.
